

**MONSIGNOR FEENEY FOUNDATION  
2006 FANTASY LOTTERY  
OFFICIAL RULES**

1. This charitable lottery is a project of the Monsignor Feeney Foundation for Catholic Schools. The Monsignor Feeney Foundation, 795 Wonderland Rd., S., Suite 207, London, Ontario N6K 3C2 holds the license to conduct this lottery. All inquires regarding the “Chance of winning” is to be made to the licensee prior to the purchase of tickets. For inquiries please call 663-4463 or 1-888-946-9797. There are 603 prizes in total. The total value of the prize board is \$700,000. All prizes are tax-exempt.
2. A total of 40, 000 tickets will be available for sale at \$40 each or 3 for \$100. 41,000 tickets will be printed – 40,000 tickets available for sale and 1,000 will be utilized to replace tickets that are declared void. The tickets will be printed in sequential order. Tickets 40,001 through 41,000 will be utilized to replace tickets that are declared void. Chances of winning will depend on the number of tickets sold. Ticket price is not tax deductible. Only one method of payment will be accepted. Only one mailing address will be accepted. The first name on the ticket will be deemed the winner. Tickets may have two names recorded on the ticket. Tickets cannot be purchased in the name of a minor. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. Tickets may be paid for by cash, money order, cheque, VISA or MasterCard. In the case of payment by credit card or cheque, tickets will not be considered sold and will not be entered into any draw until the credit card invoice has been authorized or the cheque has cleared the bank. In the event of a non-authorized credit card or NSF cheque, that ticket will be deemed “not sold” and at the option of the Foundation will be resold. Postdated cheques are not accepted.
3. Tickets must be purchased in the Province of Ontario, Canada.
4. All cash prizes are tax-exempt.
5. Any transfer or splitting of cash prizes must be done independently of the Monsignor Feeney Foundation.
6. Tickets may be purchased over the telephone by calling 1-888-946-9797 or 663-4464. The operator will record your information, including credit card number on your ticket stub. Tickets may be purchased by mail or in person at branches of the Bank of Montreal in the counties of Huron, Perth, Oxford, Elgin, London & Middlesex, Kent and Lambton. Complete and sign the ticket stub, including money order, cheque or credit card number. Tickets will be mailed to the purchaser at the address on the ticket stub when ordered by phone, tickets will be handed out at the Bank of Montreal branches. Tickets ordered by phone will be mailed out within two weeks of the purchase date (the date your credit card is authorized or your cheque clears the bank). Ticket payment must be received in full for the ticket purchase to be valid. If you do not receive your ticket in the mail within two weeks, please call 1-888-946-9797 or 664-4464 to confirm your ticket number (duplicate tickets cannot be issued).

7. Prizes are all cash, to be paid by cheque to the winner and must be accepted as awarded, are not transferable, and may not be accepted in the name of other than the name of the person whose name appears on the ticket stub.
8. The liability of the Monsignor Feeney Foundation shall be limited to the ticket price of \$40.
9. The lottery will be launched on August 4, 2006. Draws will be conducted under the supervision of the Lottery Promoter's auditors, Johnston, Benson, Inkster & Brighton, (the Auditor's). The draws for all prizes will take place at the Foundation office, 795 Wonderland Rd. S. Suite 207, London, Ontario.
10. The draws take place weekly according to the following schedule:  
40 weekly draws starting on September 11, 2006. Prizes are drawn in order of highest value to lowest value. On draw dates containing bonus draws, the bonus draw will take place first followed by the regular weekly draw in order of highest value to lowest value. Winning tickets are eligible for all subsequent draws.

7. Winners of prizes will be notified by Canada Post and/or telephone within two weeks of the draw having taken place at the address and/or telephone number on their ticket stub. The notification will advise them that they have been selected as a winner and will identify the procedure that must be followed for that person to obtain their prize. To obtain their prize, the person whose name is drawn must do the following: they must follow instructions as outlined in the “Prize Notification/Release Letter” that will be sent to them indicating that they are in compliance with and confirming that they agree to these Official Rules and which includes an affidavit of release of liability confirming the Lottery promoters and those associated with them accept no liability whatsoever in relation to the winning of the prize or the use of the prize
11. If any “Prize Winner’s Notification/Release Letter” for any of the prizes is not properly signed and returned by September 11, 2007, the Foundation will make an attempt to contact the winner by phone. Winner’s will have been contacted by Canada Post, Internet website and by phone. In such situation as the Lottery Promoter could not contact the prize winner, no other person who entered the Charitable Lottery will be awarded the prize in question, and unclaimed prizes will be administered under the provisions within the Ontario Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario’s act.
12. A complete list of final prize winners will be published on the Foundation’s website **[www.monsignorfeeneyfoundation.com](http://www.monsignorfeeneyfoundation.com)** on the Friday following the draws. A final list of winners will be posted in the London Free Press on June 29, 2007. To obtain a list of winners, send a stamped, self addressed envelope to the following address: List of Winners, c/o Monsignor Feeney Foundation for Catholic Schools, 795 Wonderland Rd. S., Suite 207, London, Ontario, N6K 3C2. Board members and employees of the Monsignor Feeney Foundation, and Johnston, Benson, Inkster and Brighton, and their immediate families residing in the same

household are not eligible to win a prize. Only those who are 18 years of age or older may purchase a ticket and are eligible to win a prize. By entering and accepting a prize, that person consents to the use of their name, address, and photograph for publicity purposes, without compensation and without limitation.

13. No correspondence will be entered into except with the winners. If any matter relating to this lottery is in dispute, the decision of the Lottery Promoters shall be final. If any matter relating to the draws is in dispute, the decision of the Auditors shall be deemed correct in regard to draws. The Lottery is subject to all Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws and regulations.
